

County Recreation Wins Public Relations Award

The Palm Beach County Parks and Recreation Department was selected by the Florida Recreation and Park Association (FRPA) as the winner of the 2018 Public Relations Award for its animated video series which draws attention to the positive impacts parks and recreation makes in the areas of health, economic development, environmental sustainability, and community building.

The free trees are part of the nonprofit Arbor Day Foundation's Trees for America campaign, a program dedicated to environmental stewardship through the planting of trees.

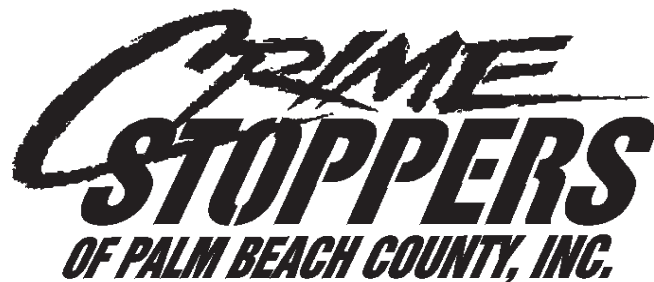
Everyone who joins the Arbor Day Foundation in October will receive 10 colorful trees and bushes selected for your area.

Criminal Justice Job Fair at PBSC

LAKE WORTH -- More than 20 police departments and other organizations seeking law enforcement, corrections and 911 dispatch personnel will recruit at the Criminal Justice Job Fair, Friday, Oct. 19, from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m., at Palm Beach State College. Free and open to the public, the fair will be held at PBSC's Public Safety Conference Center, room PSD 108, on the Lake Worth campus, 4200 Congress Ave.

It is the second annual job fair that PBSC has held in partnership with the National Organization of Black Law Enforcement Executives (NOBLE). The Palm Beach County Association of Chiefs of Police also have joined the effort this year.

The exhibiting organizations include the U.S. Navy, Florida Highway Patrol, Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office, Palm Beach County School District and the police

departments from Boca Raton, Boynton Beach, Coconut Creek, Delray Beach, Fort Lauderdale, Hollywood, Lakeland, Landerhill, Manalapan, Margate, Miami-Dade, Oceanridge, Orlando, Palm Beach, Polk County, Riviera Beach, Seminole and West Palm Beach (including 911 dispatch).

Attendees will be able to apply for current job openings ranging from officer to civilian positions. Both certified and noncertified individuals and students are encouraged to attend.

"The job fair will enable our current and past recruits, as well as local job seekers, to speak directly with agency representatives about benefits, hiring specifics and specialized units," said Rick Rocco, director of PBSC's Criminal Justice programs. "PBSC works continuously with the law enforcement community to not only help our stu-

dents succeed, but also to support the efforts of all who aspire to start or advance a career in law enforcement."

Palm Beach State will exhibit as the leading educator of public safety professionals in Palm Beach County. Attendees will be able to gather information on the College's various degree and certificate programs in criminal justice, fire science, emergency medical services (including EMT and paramedic), emergency management, and various advanced, cross-over and career programs, such as Public Safety Telecommunications, which trains 911 dispatchers.
