Grant Projects

- Clean Water Indiana
- The SWCD partners with SWCDs in Pike, Gibson, and Posey Counties to offer cost share for a bundle of conservation practices, including cover crops, soil testing, and no till. This \$75,000, three year project has been very successful, and concluded at the end of 2017.

• The SWCD partnered with Spencer and Perry Counties on a three year project for livestock producers, funded for 2016-2018. The SWCD has provided cost share for the construction of Heavy Use Protection Areas, Watering Pads, and Pasture Renovation. Funding remains for one more year.

• The SWCD participates in other pass through grant projects as they become available. The Nature Conservancy offered two opportunities for landowners interested

in cover crops in 2017: through the Alcoa Foundation, and also through Caterpillar.

Other SWCD Projects and Programs

• The SWCD provides a no-till drill, erosion control blanket staplers, hand seeder, tile flags, and spinning jenny, at minimal or no cost to landowners for conservation uses.

 Staff and Supervisors maintain contact with national, state, and local elected officials by attending and hosting events, including legislative breakfasts.
