Do you know who Tyra Buss is? Tyra Buss is a senior in college. Tyra Buss goes to Indiana University. Last year Tyra Buss started all 34 games. Tyra scored 18.2 points per game. In all of the games she scored a total of 619 points in her first season, and broke the most points scored by women. Tyra finished in 34th place in the nation in points scored. Tyra became the fastest player in school history. That season she scored 1,000 points and ended her junior campaign 8th all-time in scoring(1,601). Tyra scored the most points of any player in her junior year. Tyrabeat the boy all time leader (Denise Jackson who scored 1,601 points) in one season. Tyra Buss set a new school record for consecutive of double figure scoring at 59 points. She also started 32 of 34 games. Tyra lead IU with 18.2 points per game and that lead her to be ranked

11th in the Big Ten. Tyra put 38 points up on the board against North Carolina State, and scored a career high. Tyra got the 4th best single game performance in the history of the school. Tyra also scored 35 points against Florida, which became the 8th best single game peformance and also set a Big Ten record for most free throws in a game by scoring 19 for 20 free throws. Tyra led IU at the line and 17th place in the Big Ten. Tyra shot 81.2 percent(155 for 199). Of Tyra's 155 free throws she made second best in the Big Ten and 18th overall in thee country and her 199 attempts were 27th in the nation. Buss finished the season 2nd best in the Big Ten. She made a total of (453) points and got 4th place in free throw attempts (594). In 13 contests she scored more than 20 points so Tyra led IU in scoring in 20 games. Tyra also recorded a team high as 158 assists(4.6 per game) as she dished out multiple assists in every game and ranked 8th in the Big Ten in that certain category. She set a new career high with 10 assists in the win over Northern Kentucky which was part of two of her doubles this season.


