Hot Air Balloon Rides will be offered Wednesday and Thursday night.

Red, White and You Bicentennial baby and children's pageants will begin at 6 p.m. Wednesday in the Community Building at Rockport City Park. The Deaconess Mobile Breast Center will also be on site Wednesday to offer screenings.

Forever Grateful Friday will offer

free fair admission to veterans and active duty military, plus a plethora of displays, including a replica of the USS Indiana submarine. Forever Grateful Friday will also give fairgoers a chance to express their appreciation for those who fought for our freedom.

Also on Friday, Exhibition Barrel Racing and an NPBA/NBHA Sanctioned Horse Show will be among the offerings.

A Pet Parade and a Spencer County Humane Society Adopt-a-thon will be happening at the Fair on Saturday, as well as a horseshoe tourney and Brothers of the Brush/Sisters of the Braid and other contests. A Bicentennial Bluegrass Fest will be held in the Lincoln Pioneer Village.

The Fair will culminate in the Bicentennial Bash Championship Demolition Derby, with Power Wheels and Lawnmower derbies leading up to the main event.
