column,” fellow WPCI member, Florence Webster Long says, “through which she was known throughout her state.”

The lively, bubbly, red-headed Kate died on July 3, 1937 after a brief illness. Her final column of “The Hoosier Listening Post” was published in the Indianapolis Star three days after her death. This small town

woman — a Rockport native — paved the path for the future of women in journalism.

Not only was Kate Milner Rabb a descendant of Indiana pioneers, but a pioneer in the field of journalism when few women had the time, means or ability to write for publication and influence the destiny of women in journalism today.

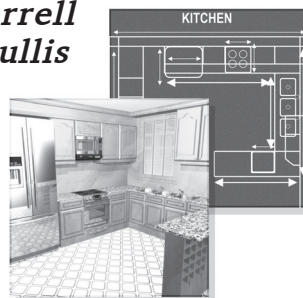
