Every quilt has a story to tell.


Take some time at the Fair to view the quilt exhibit on Monday, July 16 from 6-8 p.m. in the Clover Pavilion.

A quilt block contest will also be part of the festivities. Any Dubois County resident over the age of 19 (or a member of the Dubois County Extension Homemakers organization) can enter the quilt block contest. Quilt blocks should be no larger than 18"x18" and no smaller than 8"x8". Quilt blocks may be embroidered,

pieced, painted, cross-stitched or stenciled. Hand- or machine-sewn blocks will also be accepted. Blocks should be ready for quilting but not quilted; blocks marked for quilting will be accepted.

The top three quilt blocks will be cho-



sen by a people's choice ballot during the Fair. Check-in will be in Exhibit Building 2 (north door) on Friday, July 13 from 3-7 p.m. All blocks will be on display throughout Fair week and will be released on Saturday, July 21 from 8 a.m.-1 p.m.


Kiddie Pedal Tractor Pull
