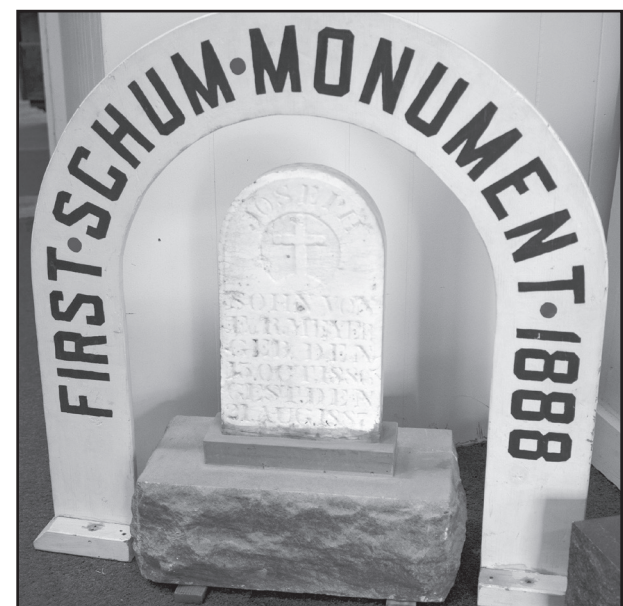
a piece to adorn landscaping. Schum's are also working with the American Legion in Ferdinand for the Veteran's Monument to be completed by next Memorial Day.

For 130 years — from hammer and chisel ("I don't know how he did it, I really, truly don't," says Sandy of her grandfather) to the technological advances that still allow artistry to rule the day — Schum Monuments, Inc. has been a leader in the field.

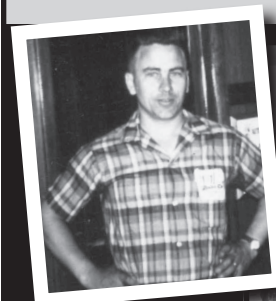
