Children's Games begin at 9:30 a.m. Saturday, immediately following the pet parade.

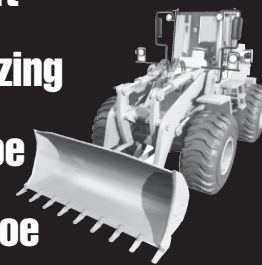
