21 years of markt elegance

Artist and calligrapher, Sabrina Verkamp, shares her expertise

With a flick of the calligrapher's pen, the letter A kicks it leg, Es and Fs stretch curly arms, and Qs twist their tails through the tops of Ts...

Visitors to Sabrina Verkamp's Christ-

kindlmarkt booth stand back in amazement as she gracefully, deliberately showcases her skills: the Ferdinand native has studied classical calligraphy for more than 25 years.

An artist by trade, Verkamp became interested in calligraphy while working at nearby Saint Meinrad Archabbey. There, under the direction of Benedictine monk and calligrapher, Fr. Eric Lies,

OSB, Verkamp trained in the strict, oldworld rules of the ancient art. At the time, her revered instructor was "90-something vears old," she tells.

"He helped me hone my skills," says the artist, "and since then I've attended conferences, both national and international, where I fine tune."

Samples of Verkamp's fine-tuned expression abound in 170 x 135 pixel rectangles

> on the main page of her Etsy shop, Artfully SV. Here, guests' names embellish traditional silver-lined placecards and other popular wedding and banquet decor - river rocks, ornamental stones, agates, sea glass and driftwood.

> Some names are written in proud calligraphy of past centuries; others swerve and dash in less fussy, contemporary styles. There are letters that look like they

listen to hip-hop, and a few are in the quiet lowercase of old typesetting.

Sharp blacks and whites, iridescent purples and stunning silvers prance across ornaments and pirouette around wine glasses, Baby's 1st *Christmas*; *Mother of the Bride*.

At time of press, the shop enjoys 534 reviews, all five stars, from 2,084 sales. "With today's marketplace," professes Verkamp, "where things are so mass produced, I like that I'm able to offer something that has that personal touch to it. That is hand done."

At her markt booth, SV Calligraphy & Art, Verkamp displays a curated collection of her wares, including holiday

ornaments. Verkamp's hand-painted glass and shatter-proof balls swirl with painted snowmen and original Christmas designs. The ornaments may be personalized onsite, and a special ornament called "Our Grandkids" is one of Verkamp's top sellers. There are wedding, engagement and memorial ornaments, and the designer also paints original snowmen and winter
