To shoppers' delight, Verkamp also brings her hand-painted and engraved glassware to the markt. Much of Verkamp's work is inspired by nature, and on her glassware, it shows. "I love trees," says the artist, "so a lot of times I engrave a tree, wrapping it around the glass." Wine-lovers will adore her exquisite, intricately engraved stemware, which make gorgeous table decorations for holidays, an-
