# TOWN OF GOODMAN PUBLIC INDECENCY ORDINANCE An ordinance stating it shall be unlawful

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for any person to willfully perform any public indecent act within the corporate limits on the Town of Goodman, Mississippi, where a person should reasonably expect to be in view of the public. These acts are defined as follows;

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any rson, who is within the corporate limits of the Town of Goodman, Mississippi, to perform an act or simulated act of sexual intercourse or masturbation.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any rson, who is within the corporate limits of the Town of Goodman, Mississippi, to expose their genitals.

Section 3. It shall be unlawful for any person, who is within the corporate limits of the Town of Goodman, Mississippi, a lewd appearance in a state of partial or complete nudity

Section 4. It shall be unlawful for any person, who is within the corporate limits of the Town of Goodman, Mississippi, a lewd caress or indecent fondling of the body of another person.

Section 5. It shall be unlawful for any person, who is within the corporate limits of the Town of Goodman, Mississippi, a lewd caress indecent fondling of the sexual organs of any person, including oneself.

Section 6. It shall be unlawful for any erson, who is within the corporate limits of the Town of Goodman, Mississippi, to be found urinating or defecating in such a public place.

Section 7. It shall be unlawful for any person, who is within the corporate limits of the Town of Goodman, Mississippi, who appears to be wearing pants or skirts more than three inches below the top of the hips (crest of the ilium) exposing the skin or undergarments
