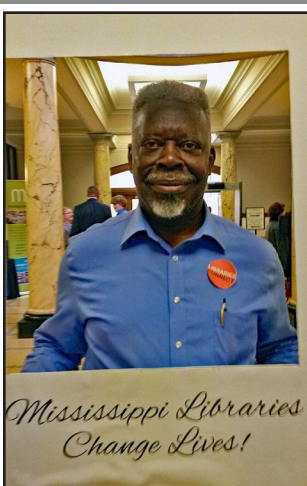
We want to keep Brother Charlie Long and his wife Sandy in our prayers along with Buddy and Lynn Hathcock's grandson, who is recovering from surgery.
