An expecting mother has contracted walking pneumonia, preeclampsia, started suffering kidney failure and will soon deliver her fist child, three months early.

That was the truth Kisha Flanigan and husband Jason of Goodman had to face while anticipating the birth of their son Karter. They planned for a February 2016 delivery, instead it was November 2015.

Kisha and Jason Flanagin along with son Karter were selected as the March of Dimes Ambassador Family 2018.

March of Dimes is a nonprofit organization that works to improve the health of mothers and babies by preventing birth defects, premature birth and infant mortality. An organization the Flanigans have embraced fully in adjusting to new ways of life.
