The Lady Trojans track team is officially the number one AA team in Mississippi. The state meet was held on Saturday, May 5 at Jackson Preparatory.

From both track and field events the girls earned a total of 194 points.

The Trojans track team had 72 points following the field events and 2 mile on Friday before adding another 122 points on Saturday.

Out of the eighteen events, the Lady Trojans finished 1st in nine events, 2nd in five events, 3rd in three events and 5th in one.

The overall win was highlighted by Breann Bell's three individual gold medals in the 3200, 1600 and 800 meter runs and her anchor leg on the gold medal, 3200 meter relay. Jordan Pritchard and Christyn Allen were able to secure individual golds in the 100 meter Hurdles and the Pole Vault, respectively.

The meet was the last for senior Rayne Tate, who ran legs on three winning sprint relays and secured a silver in the 400 meter run with a career best 62 and a bronze in the high jump. This year was

Tate's second title. It was also the last meet for seniors Paige Wynne and Madison Adcock who contributed in the distance runs and pole vault, respectively.

Lady Trojan Coach Nikki Edwards garnered her second state title along with two runner up titles in the past four years.
