Rogers started his career after college at Jackson State University in 2001, coaching at his alma mater. From there, Rogers has coached at Fairley High School and Wooddale High School in Memphis.

"My wife's mom got ill then we moved back closer to home," said Rogers. "Mc-Comb, Mississippi, that's where my wife is from. Her mom was living in Jackson at that time. So we moved back and I was offensive coordinator at Murrah High School. I was there four years, then I got the job at Vicksburg High School and was the head coach there for three and a half years. This past season I was the offensive coordinator at Provine."

Following that, Rogers took the helm of the newly consolidated Holmes County High School football program in April.

"I've been here since April," said Rogers. "Everything is still rocking and rolling. April 10 was my first day. We hit the ground running, as far as football goes. The team was a little behind, technically, with technique and fundamentals. We kind of fast tracked the guys, put in some extra work in the spring and summer. Today we're just trying to stay in that 'W' (win) column."

Rogers said that some of his core group of players are a "nasty" bunch for this season.

"Our defense, our front seven is a nasty group," Rogers said. "The D-line and the linebackers, they're real aggressive. We're going to hang our hat on defense and we're going to run the football. 
