

***HCCHS' Rogers**

Thirteen years married to wife Kala and with three children, Khamauri, 14, who is also starting corner for the Jaguars football team, Mariah, 12, and Montgomery, 6, football has lent itself as a way of life, as with many southern families.

Rogers started his career after college at Jackson State University in 2001, coaching at his alma mater. From there, Rogers has coached at Fairley High School and Wooddale High School in Memphis.

"My wife's mom got ill then we moved back closer to home," said Rogers. "McComb, Mississippi, that's where my wife is from. Her mom was living in Jackson at that time. So we moved back and I was offensive coordinator at Murrah High School. I was there four years, then I got the job at Vicksburg High School and was the head coach there for three and a half years. This past season I was the offensive coordinator at Provine."

Following that, Rogers took the helm of the newly consolidated Holmes County High School football program in April.

"I've been here since April," said Rogers. "Everything is still rocking and rolling. April 10 was my first day. We hit the ground running, as far as football goes. The team was a little behind, technically, with technique and fundamentals. We kind of fast tracked the guys, put in some extra work in the spring and summer. Today we're just trying to stay in that 'W' (win) column."

Rogers said that some of his core group of players are a "nasty" bunch for this season.

"Our defense, our front seven is a nasty group," Rogers said. "The D-line and the linebackers, they're real aggressive. We're going to hang our hat on defense and we're going to run the football. We've been averaging about 298 yards a game, rushing, with Robert Jackson, Quo'Darious Crigler and Justin Smith, my quarterback, pulling the trigger kind of keeps things balanced. Up front, we've got senior Elbert Griffin, Javontis Mike and Keonte Coleman, they're all seniors, they've started before and anchored that offensive line for us."

Rogers went on to say that the Jaguars have been averaging about 41 points per game so far this season.

The district's consolidation had already provided Rogers with a ready-made team, leaving him the hard work of developing technique and fundamentals.

"We already had our nucleus," said Rogers, "we just needed those logistics to put us over the top."

The Jaguars are set to play

in Niceville, Florida on Friday, September 14, for what Rogers calls "exposure."

"I'm a big exposure guy. The kids learned that this summer, we went to six or seven camps. We went to the University of Memphis, Jones, Alcorn, Hinds, Holmes, everywhere. Fletcher Cox camp at D-1 Sports...I want the kids to see more than Holmes County; I want them to know that there's another world out there. Some of these kids have never been to Florida, have never left the state. I talked

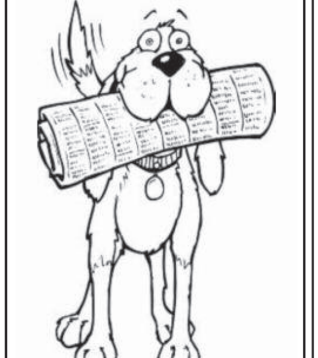
