Manchester in the opening game by a score of 9-1 and ending the day shutting out Tri-County 10-0. The games scheduled for Monday were postponed until Tuesday due to storms. At the end of the

day on Tuesday, the Lady Trojans had two more wins under their belt. Both those wins came against conference leader Marshall Academy who had defeated the Lady Trojans all three times

they faced each other this season. The Lady Trojans defeated Marshall in the first game of Monday by a score of 4-2 in a very tough battle. This loss threw Marshall into the loser's bracket

where they fought back with a win over Winona to send them back to face the Lady Trojans who are now 3-0 in the tournament. Marshall would have to have two wins against CHCS to earn the
