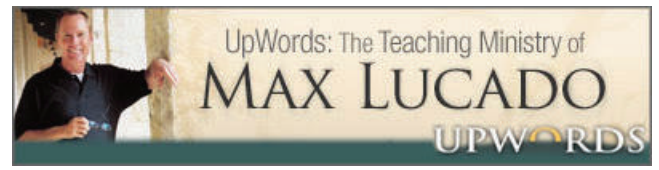
FRANK ABBOTT JONES
