In a vote of 103 to six, the Mississippi House of Representatives passed Senate Bill 3046, adopting a stronger version of the Building Roads, Improving Development and Growing the Economy Act (BRIDGE) passed earlier by the Senate.

Enactment of this measure will dedicate a new annual income stream to cities and counties for road and bridge maintenance. A new diversion of state use-tax collections will direct funds back to the cities and the counties to be



The House maintained what the Senate deemed, the Strategic Infrastructure Investment Fund (SIIF). However in the House version, the Mississippi Department of Transportation (MDOT) will administer the funds in this separate account on projects throughout the State.

The SIIF is comprised of one percent of the Rainy Day Fund, car tag monies and revenue bonded Gaming Sinking Fund dollars. This money exists separately from MDOT's annual appropriations.

In addition to the SIIF, the House legislation also authorizes \$100 million in general obligation bonds for projects
