City announces spring cleanup event

The annual spring citywide cleanup will begin on April 14 and will continue through April 21 (except Sunday). During the cleanup period, the City of Clinton will have dumpsters available for residents at the old Northside Elementary School location at 1111 Old Vicksburg Road.

City workers will be present to receive trash each day between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. The site will be closed on Sundays.

The spring cleanup days are a service to Clintonians who may have items too large to dispose of on their regularly scheduled garbage collection days. Residents can dispose of yard waste, bulky items and other household debris free of charge.

The cleanup period does not include e-waste, such as old computers, printers or keyboards, which can often be partially recycled. A separate time for disposal of e-waste and hazardous materials, such as paint and pesticides, will be offered in the fall.

Again this spring, One Shred of Hope will be on site to provide shredding services to residents wishing to dispose of sensitive documents through shredding.

While hazardous waste disposal is free to residents, the shredding service does carry a small fee for those choosing to utilize the service. Cost for shredding is \$8 for a small box, \$10 per medium box, and \$12 per large box.
