## Storm shelter space available to residents

When Clinton's newest fire station, Station #4 at 1973 Pinehaven Road, was built, its design included a "safe room" in the center of the building. The safe room, built for community use, is made of reinforced 8" thick concrete on the floor, walls and ceiling to offer shelter to residents during threatening weather events, such as a tornado or hurricane.

The safety shelter is an idea that grew from the general devastation and days of sustained power outages following Hurricane Katrina in 2005. The EF-3 tornado that wreaked havoc on a wide swath of Clinton in April 2011 also reinforced the need for such a facility.

According to Clinton Fire Chief Jeff Blackledge, the shelter is available to all residents of Clinton when weather can present a clear danger.

"Since the station first opened last December, we've probably had folks come a half dozen times during a weather

event. We have twenty-two tornado sirens scattered throughout the city, but the time to come to the shelter is not when the siren itself goes off - that means a tornado has been sighted. We don't want people out traveling to get to a safe place once a tornado warning has already been sounded."

Blackledge reminded Clintonians to always be weather-aware and not to rely on the sirens.

## Aldermen pass 2018-19 budget in close vote

In a close vote taken at a 7 a.m. September 14 meeting, the City's Board of Aldermen passed the 2018-19 \$17.6 million budget in public session, with

two aldermen absent and the Mayor casting the deciding vote for approval.

The \$17,652.079 budget is a four percent increase over the previous year's \$16,979,106 budget, with no tax increase.

The vote was a public meeting, as stipulated under Mississippi Code 25-41-5. State law also provides that "a public body may conduct any meeting through teleconference or video means...provided that the equipment used is located at the place where the public body normally meets... and provided that the equipment allows all members of the public body and members of the public who attend the meeting to hear the deliberations of the public body."

The statute was employed to accommodate the participation by phone of Ward 5 Alderwoman Jan Cossitt, who was absent due to illness.

The proposed budget, highlighted by
