Young Tide go 6-5 to open season

It was the tale of two days for the Edgerton High School volleyball team. The Crimson Tide lost four of six matches Friday, Aug. 24, in an invitational hosted by Janesville Craig and Janesville Parker, but then won four of five matches in day two of the tournament on Saturday, Aug. 25.

Edgerton was bumped down to consolation play after day one of the tournament, eventually falling to Sauk Prairie 23-25, 25-18, 13-15 in the consolation semifinal.

The Crimson Tide finished with a record of 6-5 at the tournament.

“The results look better, but we were playing a much different level of competition,” head coach Sharon Fox said.

In the first day of tournament action, Edgerton collected losses to Brodhead (25-23, 21-25, 11-15), Janesville Parker (25-15, 16-25, 14-16), Madison Memorial (17-25, 16-25) and Baraboo (17-25, 16-25). The Crimson Tide’s two wins came over Portage (25-15, 25-15) and Delavan-Darien (25-15, 25-14).

Sophomore Carly Rebman led the Tide in kills on Friday, with 45 in the team’s six games. Setting up for Edgerton was freshman Kate Fox Gunderson, who collected 102 assists on day one.

On Saturday, the Tide

won four straight matches, with wins over Portage (25-22, 25-10), Cambridge (25-11, 25-15), Delavan-Darien (25-18, 21-25, 15-4) and Elkhorn (25-14, 25-20). With a chance to make it to the consolation championship game, Edgerton dropped a heartbreaker to Sauk Prairie (23-25, 25-18, 13-15).

“I would have like to see us finish close matches that I believe we should have come out on top,” Fox said.

Once again Rebman led the Tide in kills, recording 59 kills in the five-game span, including a season-high 16 kills against Sauk Prairie.




“I thought she played solid all weekend, she led us in kills every single game,” Fox said. “Her backrow play continues to be impressive.”

Fox Gunderson continued her helpful hand, compiling 78 assists, which included a 19-assist performance versus Sauk Prairie.

Senior Emma Fox did the dirty work for the Tide in the tournament, leading Edgerton in digs in seven games.

“The team needs to learn to bring the energy and intensity throughout the whole match,” Fox said. “They’re still learning to play together.”

The Crimson Tide played in a tournament on Tuesday, Aug.28, hosted at Madison La Follette High School. Results were not available by time of publication.


