

Catch the 'King' and more in EPAC

Bringing quality, affordable entertainment to the Edgerton community has been the mission of the Wartmann Endowment for the Performing Arts for the last 14 years. World-renowned artists have delivered stunning performances on the Edgerton Performing Arts Center stage. In addition, many of these artists have conducted master classes, concerts and music clinics with Edgerton's students.

The Wartmann Artist Series 2018-19 will kick off on Saturday, Oct. 20, 2018, at 7:30 p.m. with "Elvis My Way: starring Brandon Bennett." The electrifying Bennett (Chicago: Million Dollar Quartet) does the impossible, delivering a spine-tingling Elvis tribute that is fresh, powerful and right on time. With his pure-bred southern charm, powerful voice, and scandalous moves, Bennett was named the "Ultimate Elvis Tribute Artist" by Elvis Presley Enterprises at Graceland. His must-see show traverses Elvis' career: from the Rock n' Roll nativity of the '50s, to the iconic comeback television concert of the '60s, to the legendary lounge acts of the '70s. All-time great hits include "Blue Suede Shoes," "Can't Help Falling In Love," "Suspicious Minds" and many more. The concert is being presented by Artists Lounge Live (www.artistslounge.com).

On Saturday, Nov. 17, 2018, at 7:30 p.m., The Rodney Marsalis Philadelphia Big Brass (RMPBB) will bring precision, excitement and charisma to the stage. The ensemble is composed of some of America's top brass musicians dedicated to bringing the joyous experience of great music to a wide range of audiences. A group that always reflects the diverse makeup of men and women in American culture, RMPBB is dedicated to the notion that music is a gift to be enjoyed by everyone.

RMPBB is especially dedicated to reaching out to the world's youth and inspiring them to reach for their dreams. A veritable "dream team" of virtuoso brass players, members of the group have appeared on the world's most prominent stages and performed with groups like the Metropolitan Opera Orchestra, Philadelphia Orchestra, Chamber Music Society of Lincoln Center, Baltimore Symphony, São Paulo State Symphony Orchestra, Imani Winds, Canadian Brass and the Boston Brass. The group burst onto the music scene with a debut performance in Philadelphia's Kimmel Center in Verizon Hall, a residency for the Mann Center for the Performing Arts and a special feature on the National Public Radio show "All Things Considered."

Acclaimed Broadway veterans Franc D'Ambrosio and Glory Crampton celebrate the music of Andrew

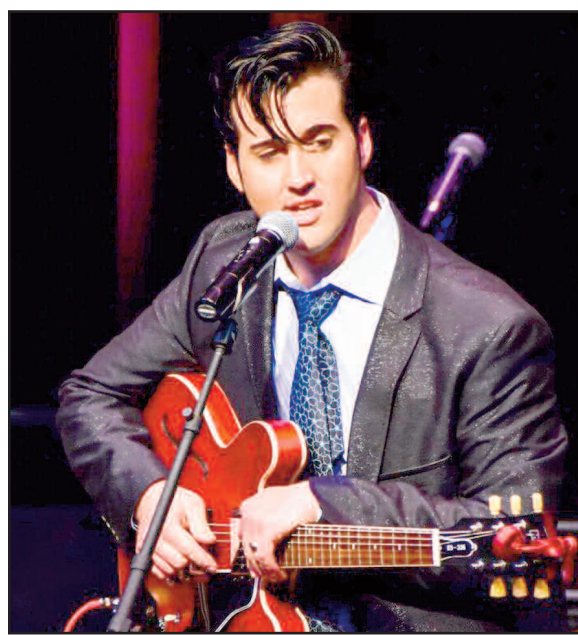

Broadway leading lady Glory Crampton is a musical theatre veteran with an exquisite soprano voice who is best known for her critically acclaimed roles in productions of Phantom, Nine, Camelot, The Fantasticks, My Fair Lady and Carousel. Glory is also an accomplished soprano solo artist.

Franc D'Ambrosio has joined the ranks of the famed Michael Crawford and Sarah Brightman as only a handful of Phantom alumni to successfully cross over to solo careers. Franc is best known for his role as the Phantom in Andrew Lloyd Webber's The Phantom of the Opera. With more than 2,300 performances, he held the title of 'World's Longest Running Phantom' for nearly a decade. Franc is also known for his role as Anthony Corleone in the Academy Award-nominated film The Godfather: Part III. Franc sang the Academy Award winning theme song from the film trilogy.

Building on more than three generations of Leahy musicianship, Doug Leahy, together with his wife Jennifer and their children, are keeping those traditions alive through music, song and dance. On Saturday, May 11, 2019, at 7:30 p.m. The Next Generation Leahy will explode on stage! The drive to create music is powerful within each of the Leahy children. It has given rise to multi-instrumental talents whose dynamic live performances have been described as "astounding" and "breathtaking." With these young minds leading the way, their music is constantly evolving, bringing Celtic music into the modern era for a new audience. In all of their music The Next Generation Leahy take their passion for music, song and dance – which flows from every pore in their bodies – and create something new and vibrant.
