

individual and also earned HOL MVP honors last season.



Last year the Hawley girls golf team finished third in the conference but did not advance to the section tournament. Coach Ben Gunkelman said Hawley should do well this year. Last year, three of the girls received an all-conference award. The three all-conference golfers returning this year are Zoe Dauner, Lauren Sellin, and Faith Justesen.

"This year there are 30-plus girls signed up for the 2018 season," Gunkleman said. "So I'll have three co-captains this year, Dauner, Riley Larson-Adams, and Sellin. The returning varsity golfers are Dauner, Sellin, Justesen, Maggie Huesman, and Larson-Adams. There are also a lot of junior varsity golfers returning as well."

This is Gunkelman's 10th year coaching girls golf in Hawley and his sixth year as the head coach. He is a science teacher at Hawley High School and also a council member for the City of Hawley. Chris Baxter will be returning for his third year as assistant coach. Baxter is a physical

education teacher at Hawley Elementary School.

"This year's main asset is the number of varsity players I have returning as well as the number of returning junior varsity players," Gunkelman said. "These girls have been on the course with other varsity players and know what to expect and how to perform. Also, there are a lot of JV players who could be on the varsity and this will give the team some depth, something we have not had before. It should also motivate the girls to give it their all during every practice because there are other girls who are vying for their spot on the varsity.'

This year, the team to beat will be Perham. They were the HOL champs last year and are bringing back most (if not all) of their starters. They were a solid team last year and Gunkelman expects the same competition from them this year.

The team's goal this year is to claim the top spot in the conference. Almost all of the varsity players from last year are returning and if they can put up the scores they are capable of, Hawley will have a chance at winning the conference. Hawley hopes to have one girl or more advance to the section tournament and even the state tournament.

"All the varsity girls bring

something unique to the team," Gunkelman added. "The varsity consists of girls from 8th to 11th grade, and each person will be a leader in her own grade. I see the cocaptains being the most prominent leaders on the team and showing the other players how their years of experience and determination have
