



## Lady Trojans Gear Up For Track and Field Season



Mike Schaub is back as head coach of the Barnesville Lady Trojans Track and Field team for 2018. Schaub, who is entering his 12th season as the leader of the program and his 18th season overall, returns another youthful roster of athletes that are looking to improve upon their 2017 performances.

Barnesville has only two seniors on the roster for the upcoming season as Allison Peterson and Kaitlyn Thompson enter their final campaign. Peterson will participate in the sprints, relays and jumps, with Thompson running the distance events.

"We finished in the top seven, as a team, in all regular season track and field meets last season," said Schaub. "We finished 3rd out of 15 teams in the Section 6A True Team meet and sixth at Sub-Sections. We also advanced 11 athletes to the Section 8A meet and finished in 14th

Rietz, Emily Smith and Tori Wacker.

"Emily Schoenecker placed second at Sections, earning a trip to the State Track and Field Meet, where she finished in 22nd place. We expect big things from Emily again in 2018, while looking for improvements with all our athletes throughout this season. They are great athletes that have excellent work ethics. It should be a fun season."

Barnesville will once again compete in the Heart O' Lakes Conference, Sub-Section 30 and Section 8A.

Schaub will focus on coaching

work with the girls in the shot put and discus, while Chad Suter enters his first season as the boys assistant coach and will focus on the long and

triple jump events. McKinzie Tangen is also in her first season working the hurdlers, jumps and Junior High.

Captains for the 2018 season will be Elora Passa, Claire Meyer and Emily Spilde. Coach Schaub believes that Perham will be the HOL Conference favorite this season with Park Rapids leading the pack to win

Section 8A. "I am excited to see how all our athletes will perform this season," said Schaub. "Emily Schoenecker is our only returning athlete to make it to the state meet. She will continue to participate in the long jump, 200 meter dash and sprint relays. Another athlete to watch for is Jordan Tschumperlin. Jordan set a school record in the triple jump last season and looks to excel in that event as well as the high jump and sprint relays. Both girls attended many camps in the off-season to improve in their events. It will be fun season to get under way.'
