



Kids Put Pedal Power To The Test

Tractor pulls and parades are a standing tradition at county fairs. The kids are not left behind as they have their own form of power: putting foot power to the pedal.

Kids will compete for boasting rights and trophies at this year's Pedal Power Pull Sunday, July 15, 1:00 p.m. in

front of the fair office.

The youngsters will use their own leg power to test their endurance and find who can pull the weighted sled the greatest distance.

Boys and girls, ages four to 11 years old, compete in appropriate age categories. There are no fees

and kids can still sign up the day of the event.

Trophies will be given to first, second and third place finishers, with the top two winners advancing to the Minnesota State Pedal Tractor Pull. Previous winners can participate again but cannot qualify for the state competition twice.

Winners are determined by pulling a weighted sled the greatest distance.

Every contestant receives a bottle of milk. Pedal tractors and equipment are furnished.
