


2018 Barnesville Trojan Football Seniors

Favorite Football Memory: When Nick Detloff got triple thrusted in the Roseau game.


Coaches Comments: Jacob did a great job for us on special teams this year and played some corner as well. Jacob is a very hard worker and a great young man to have around. He is always smiling.

championship three years in a row. Coaches Comments: Brooks played linebacker for us as well as


