

# Senior Glover to lead young LHS softball squad from the circle

With a roster of 13, first-year Larned head softball coach Amy Wilson's early-season regimen includes a heavy dose of fundamentals.

"We have a lot of youngsters that are really going to step up," Wilson said. "We've been working hard on hitting the ball in practice."

Last season, a senior-heavy Lady Indians squad fell 6-1 to Hoisington in their Class 4A Division II regional opener in Larned, to end the season at 9-12.

Lost to graduation are Central Kansas League team members Hayley Skelton, third base; Maddie Erway, second base and Kelsie Parr,

first base. Sophomore outfielder Ivory Muldrow is still recuperating from a knee injury from last basketball season.

That leaves some holes to fill around the horn.

Sophomore Lynzie Myrick, who served behind the plate last season, has moved to first base; replaced by freshman catcher Shaylee Martin. At second base is freshman Abby Towery. Sophomore Kendra Grandy is at short and junior Baylea Perez at third, with sophomore Breanna Setzer, junior Alea Makings and sophomore Kaylee Krehbiel in the outfield.

Mattie Glover, who last year earned all-CKL second-team honors, returns to the mound with Perez in the starting rotation. Sophomore Kaylee Mead, Towery and fresh-
