# Young Larned squads take to track in 2018

Head track coach Tad Remy has some state contenders that he hopes will be joined by youthful performers by the time postseason arrives in May.

The Larned boys have no state-qualifying returnees from last season, but senior Thomas Harmon returns in distance after just missing a state berth in the 1,600m last season. At regionals last year, Harmon also placed seventh in the 800m and anchored the 4x800 to seventh place at Buhler.

Remy is also looking to sophomore Brock Skelton, whose triple-jump efforts are closing in on 42 feet.

"The boys' field is wide open to athletes who want to be competitive," Remy noted. "We have a lot of young athletes on the roster this year that could score us points at

Meanwhile, there are no seniors on the girls' side. Several juniors, however could make an impact from early on, Remy noted.

Junior Katie Fischer returns to the high jump pit after clearing 5-2 for a silver medal at state last season. She is joined by sophomore Makayla Leiker, who qualified for state as a freshman alongside Fischer, and finished just shy of the state podium in ninth place.

Leiker is expected to play an expanded role this season on the oval as well, after competing in the hurdles and relays last season.

Junior Brooke Butler missed a state qualification in the 800m last year at regionals and will return to the relays. Sophomore Cierra Nord also returns to the distance races and will anchor the 4x800, Remy noted. Also returning to the 4x800 from last season are juniors Asia Murphy and Shaylee Nesby.

# LHS linksters sport young squad in 2018

Graduated seniors Colton Massey, Brandon Bartz and Braeden Corman led the Indians to second place at their regional at the Smoky Hills Country Club in Hays for a Class 4A state team qualification at Wamego last May.

The Indians won the Central Kansas League tournament while Massey successfully defended his individual title with a 2-over-par 74.

At state, Massey, a four-time state qualifier just missed winning the individual title when a three-way showdown for medalist erupted following a one-hour rain delay on the Wamego Country Club

Finishing the regulation 18 tied at 75 were Massey, four-time state qualifier Jake Becker of Augusta and junior Peyton Austin of Rose Hill. Becker won the meet on the first playoff hole, while Massey knocked down a par to win the second place playoff.

Massey's finished marked the highest individual placing for a LHS golfer in spring competition since Kendall Wilson won top honors at Wellington in 1989.

Bartz, meanwhile, shot an 85 while Corman came in at 93 at state.

This season, sophomore Hunter Barker is the only returnee from last year's state meet. Alex Sanger

is the team's lone senior, while Barker is joined by sophomore classmates Callen Ayre, Jared McFadden
