The best rate of gain in each species - beef, sheep, and goat - will be awarded a \$25 cash award. This year's contest spanned 83 days for the small animals and 131 days for the beef. The rate of gain contest awards are presented by Bert & Wetta Larned, Inc.

The beef division winner gained 458 lbs in 131 days with an average daily gain of 3.5 lbs. The beef rate of gain winner is Halle Barker.

The winner's market lamb gained 73 lbs in 83 days with an average daily gain of .88 lbs. The sheep rate of gain winner is Jaidyn Pinkston.

The meat goat division winner gained 39 lbs in 83 days with an average daily gain of .47 lbs. The market goat winner is Mya Hill.
