September 22 at Kiwanis Park

Pumpkins make the perfect canvas for autumn creativity, particularly for youthful artists.

Soleil Garden Center in Union City will be providing dozens and dozens of the orange globes again this year, so that children can dip brushes in paint and express themselves at Kiwanis Park. Family Day in the Park fun will take place from 9 a.m.-3 p.m. Sept. 22 in the downtown family gathering spot, with children of all ages welcome to take a free pumpkin and make it their own, artistically speaking. Pumpkins are traditionally displayed near the picnic tables where young artists make their visions real, but creative kids are welcome to take their pumpkins home with them at any point.

The fun will begin about 10 a.m. and continue until the pumpkin patch is empty or artists finish their work, a spokesman said.
