

Cornbread Cookoff

September 22 at Kiwanis Park

It's the first annual Obion County CornFest Cornbread Cookoff!

Join festivalgoers at Family Day in the Park on Sept. 22.

It's free to enter. Bring your homemade cornbread to the gazebo in Kiwanis Park between 9 and 10 a.m. during Family Day in the Park. Winners will be announced at 11 a.m. and participants must be present to win.

Cash prizes will be awarded for three age categories: Ages 5-9, 10-17 and 18 and older. First-place winners will receive \$25, second place \$15 and third place \$10.

To enter, bring three pieces of homemade cornbread on a paper plate, wrapped in clear wrap or foil. The entrant's name, address, email address and phone number must be written on the bottom of the plate. Recipe must also accompany each cornbread entry.

There is only one entry per person.
