Every year, since 1996, the Rollag Pioneer Press puts out a new edition during WMSTR. Articles that have made the front page of the Rollag Pioneer Press: Big Red Comes To Rollag For National IHC Expo (98), Massey-Harris Is Famous For Wild Harvest Brigade (99), and 2014 Sand Box Expo.

But let's take a few steps

back, long before the Rollag Pioneer Press hit the stands and computers replaced typewriters. Bob Brekken, Mathew Sorem and Jerome Ekre started out running the 1917 Model Linotype, donated by Ada Index newspaper, and the 1920s 9x12 Chandler and Price Press, donated by the Hawley Herald, operating out of the Freeport Engine building. In 1975, that all changed when WMST members raised the roof of the Rollag Pioneer Press north of the Main Street.

The Rollag Pioneer Press has been making history ever since while featuring a wealth
