Anne Manderud served as postmaster from 1980 to 2005 in Walcott and filled in at the Felton and Hawley Post Office when needed. Vanessa Nielsen, Onamia Postmaster, also works in the Rollag Post Office and oversees the stamp stock and orders the rubber stamps.

The Colfax Post Office is now known as the Rollag Post Office and is located on Main Street. It is celebrating its twentieth year on Steamer Hill, but when you step into the old mailbox, it's as though you were mailed back in time. The original screenline (the wooden divider wall that separates the employee workroom from the customer area) that was moved from one store to the next still stands. Letters still sit behind little windows that require a
