


Hill is a two volume set of books printed in 1732 on handmade paper and bound with a sheep skin cover. The books are printed in Latin text with inserts of Hebrew, Greek, and mid-eastern text and records the history of the Reformation of the Christian Church in the 1500s. I was informed that the paper for these books was handmade, one page at a time and the printing was done on a Gutenberg wooden press; a style much older than the iron 1871 Washington Press.
