YOUR TEARS CAN BE TURNED TO JOY!

Ever since, "... sin entered the world, and death by sin ..." (Rom. 5:12), rivers of tears have been shed! Not everyone sheds tears for the same reason. One may cry because of physical pain or because they aren't getting their way. Still others may shed tears because of anger, embarrassment, death, depression, or even joy. There can be pretentious crying or crying because one can no longer participate in that which is sinful.

Our hearts are greatly touched when we read of the false report of Joseph's death and the agony of Jacob's words, "For I will go down into the grave unto my son mourning ..." (Gen. 37:35). We also have great empathy, upon reading King David's heart wrenching weeping, "... O my son Absalom, my son, my son Absalom! Would God I had died for thee, O Absalom, my son, my son" (2 Sam. 18:33)!

While physical death brings weeping, there are other things that are even more heart wrenching. Take for example, the fulfillment of Christ's prophecy to Peter instantly brought tears, "And Peter remembered the word of Jesus, which said unto him, Before the cock crow, thou shalt deny me thrice. And he went out, and wept bitterly" (Mat. 26:75). Then there is Paul's great concern for the body of Christ, the church. "... that by the space of three years, I ceased not to warn every one night and day with tears" (Acts 20:31).

The shortest verse in the Bible speaks of the love and compassion of Christ in two words, "Jesus wept" (Jno. 11:35). When Jesus looked upon the city of Jerusalem He "wept over it" (Lk. 19:41). When our Lord was in the garden of Gethsemane, knowing what lay ahead, the Bible says, "And being in agony he prayed more earnestly: and his sweat was as it were great drops of blood falling down to the ground" (Lk. 22:44). We are given further insight of Jesus's agony in the garden by the Hebrew writer, "Who in the days of his flesh, when he offered up prayers and supplications with strong crying and tears unto that him that was able to save him from death ..." (Heb. 5:7).

God's great love for man is seen in the giving of "His only begotten Son" (Jno. 3:16) to die for the sins of the world! "But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. Much more then, being now justified by his blood, we shall be saved from wrath through him" (Rom. 5:8-9).

To be "saved from wrath" one must believe in Christ (Jno. 8:24), repent of sins (Acts 2:38), confess Christ (Mat. 10:32) and be immersed "for the remission of sin" (Acts 2:38), and "be faithful unto death" (Rev. 2:10). My friend, your tears can be turned to joy, upon your obedience to the gospel!
