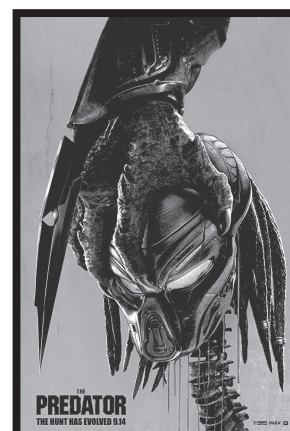

UNDERSTANDING THE MESSAGE OF THE PROPHETS

"ISAIAH - I HAVE REDEEMED THEE"

"But now thus saith the Lord that created thee, O Jacob, and he that formed thee, O Israel, Fear not: for I have redeemed thee, I have called thee by thy name; thou art mine" (Isaiah 43:1).

Isaiah chapter 43 is a promise of redemption (v1). Even before Israel/Judah was carried into captivity by the Babylonians, God promised to protect and to redeem them (v2-7). He has declared the end before the beginning, who else among all the nations can do such a thing (v8-13)? This is proof and assurance of His ability to fulfill the promise, these things will transpire even as He has promised. Babylon, who had not yet carried Israel/Judah into captivity, will fall (v14-17). Again, God would lead His people out of captivity, even as He had the exodus out of Egypt (v18-21). Not because of their own righteousness, but for His own name's sake (v22-24). It was her sins which caused Israel/Judah to be carried into Babylonian captivity, and it would be by God's grace that they would be redeemed and permitted to return to their homeland.

All men, including you and me, have sinned and fallen short of the glory of God. Paul penned, "For all have sinned and come short of the glory of God" (Romans 3:23), and again, "What then? are we better than they? No, in no wise: for we have before proved both Jews and Gentiles, that they are all under sin; As it is written, There is none righteous, no not one" (Romans 3:9-10). Since the wages of sin is spiritual death: ["For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord" (Romans 6:23)]: all mankind, from Adam to present, were/are in need of a redeemer.

Strong defines "redeemed, 1350, ... to buy back ... purchase, ransom, redeem (-er) ..." (Strong's Exhaustive Concordance, 1991, p 31). In order to redeem sinful man, Christ would have to pay the price for sin by dying on the cross in your/my place, "Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed is everyone that hangeth on a tree" (Galatians 3:13). Paul informs us that the price of man's salvation was the blood of Christ, "Take heed therefore unto yourselves, and to all the flock, over the which the Holy Ghost hath made you overseers, to feed the church of God, which he hath purchased with his own blood" (Acts 20:28).

It is in the watery grave of baptism that we come into contact with that cleansing blood of Christ, "Know ye not, that so many of us as were baptized into Jesus Christ were baptized into his death" (Romans 6:3). Ananias said unto Saul/Paul, "And now why tarriest thou? arise, and be baptized, and wash away thy sins, calling on the name of the Lord" (Acts 22:16). Peter said that baptism doth also now save us, "The like figure whereunto even baptism doth also now save us ..." (1st Peter 3:21), and again, "Can any man forbid water, that these should not be baptized ... And he commanded them to be baptized in the name of the Lord ..." (Acts 10:47-48). John stated of Jesus, "... Unto him that loved us, and washed us from our sins in his own blood" (Revelation 1:5). My friend, have you been washed clean from your sins by the blood of Christ, in the watery grave of baptism? Those who have not, like Israel of old, are still in need of the Redeemer. Have you been redeemed?
