What to see at the CIBR-BBQ

The CIBR-BBQ annually attracts many of the best competition BBQ teams in the Midwest. Here's what you can see and do in downtown Arthur this weekend at the BBQ:

- **Friday:** BBQ teams from all over the Midwest arrive for the 15th Annual Central Illinois Braggin Rights KCBS BBQ competition. There will be no food vendors on Friday.
- Later Friday evening and into the night the competition teams will begin their slow cook smoking of their competition entries for Saturday. KCBS teams prepare 4 categories of meat entries, including brisket, pork butt or shoulders, pork ribs and chicken. Some of these teams slow smoke their meats for 18 hours or longer. Come by and visit with them. They all love to talk about BBQ.
- **Saturday morning:** The teams begin to fine tune their cooking temperatures to arrive at the best possible entry for the competition turn ins beginning at noon. Their entries are judged on presentation, mouth appeal or texture, and, most importantly, taste.

Competition judging begins at Noon and continues with various meats until 2:30 p.m. Scores are tallied and awards are presented at 3:30 p.m. on East Illinois Street.
