The Historic Greenville Museum, Community Center & Library is a non-profit, tax-exempt corporation that was formed in April 2016 to save the historic Christian Church building located on the corner of Oak and Walnut streets in Greenville. This building was erected in Old Greenville about 1888-1889. When the town of Greenville disbanded after the building of Wap-papello Dam and was moved to its present location, the Christian Church was dis-mantled, its pieces numbered, and it was then rebuilt at its present location. With overwhelming support from the community and the county this building is now owned by the citizens of Wayne County and stands as an important reminder of Greenville's historic past. The building is currently being renovated.
