Piedmont was ravaged by flood water. Never before had water cascaded down Main Street.

1985

Melinda Theatre and Piedmont City Hall burn **1986** 

Piedmont IGA closes and Ralph's Supermarket opens.

1987

Walmart opens in Hal's Plaza. Nu-Dell begins production in Piedmont.

1990

Sonic opens in Piedmont.

1991

Garden Products purchases the old Hat Factory building and renovates it into a food production facility.

1992

Town and Country Supermarket purchases Ward's Food Market.

1994

Brown Shoe closes. Morrison-Worley Funeral Chapen opens in Piedmont.

1995

McDonald's opens. Corlair is the first company to locate in Piedmont's new Highway 49 Industrial Complex. The Wayne County Historical Society accepted ownership of the Aunt Beck May Log House; it was reassembled at the Piedmont Area Park. Toney's Drug Store closed after 116 years of business. The first stop light in Wayne County was installed in Piedmont.

1998

Piedmont donated land for the Clearwater Family Youth Center.

2002

After 52 years of business, Worley Log and Lumber closed.

2011

Wappapello Lake filled to capacity and topped the overflow spillway. Construction was complete on a four-lane highway through Wayne, Madison, and Butler Counties, including bypasses around Greenville and Cherokee Pass. The new divided highway opened on August 19, 2011, with a ribbon-cutting ceremony. Additionally, MoDOT has extended the divided highway south to US 160 south of Poplar Bluff.

January 2017

Walmart closes its Piedmont store. Wappapello Lake and Clearwater Lake both filled to capacity and topped the overflow spillways.
