- Park for the parade and walk to the festival grounds
- Parade to end at First Midwest Bank

Everyone loves a parade! This is definitely true in Piedmont. Main Street is always lined with a throng of people to watch the annual Ozark Heritage Festival Parade. This year's parade will march and roll through Piedmont on Saturday, October 20th to kick off Saturday's festivities.

The parade will start at Clearwater High School and run south through town. Parade line up will be begin at 9:00 am. Look for Chamber volunteers in orange vests for assistance. Registration will be held at the High School entrance from 9:00 am to 9:45 am. In order to be eligible for awards, entrants must register to be judged. Awards will be given out for first, second, and third place floats and first and second place equestrian. Awards will be handed out by the Piedmont Area Chamber of Commerce on the entertainment stage following the National Anthem.

The morning of the parade is always very hectic so please arrive at the school early and be patient. We are anticipating good weather and a great turnout.

The parade will begin at 10:00 am and proceed to the Greenway at McKenzie Creek where it will disperse. The parade will feature classic cars, antique tractors, area businesses, emergency personnel, boy scouts, girls scouts, veterans organizations and more. Clearwater High School and Greenville High School have committed to perform.
