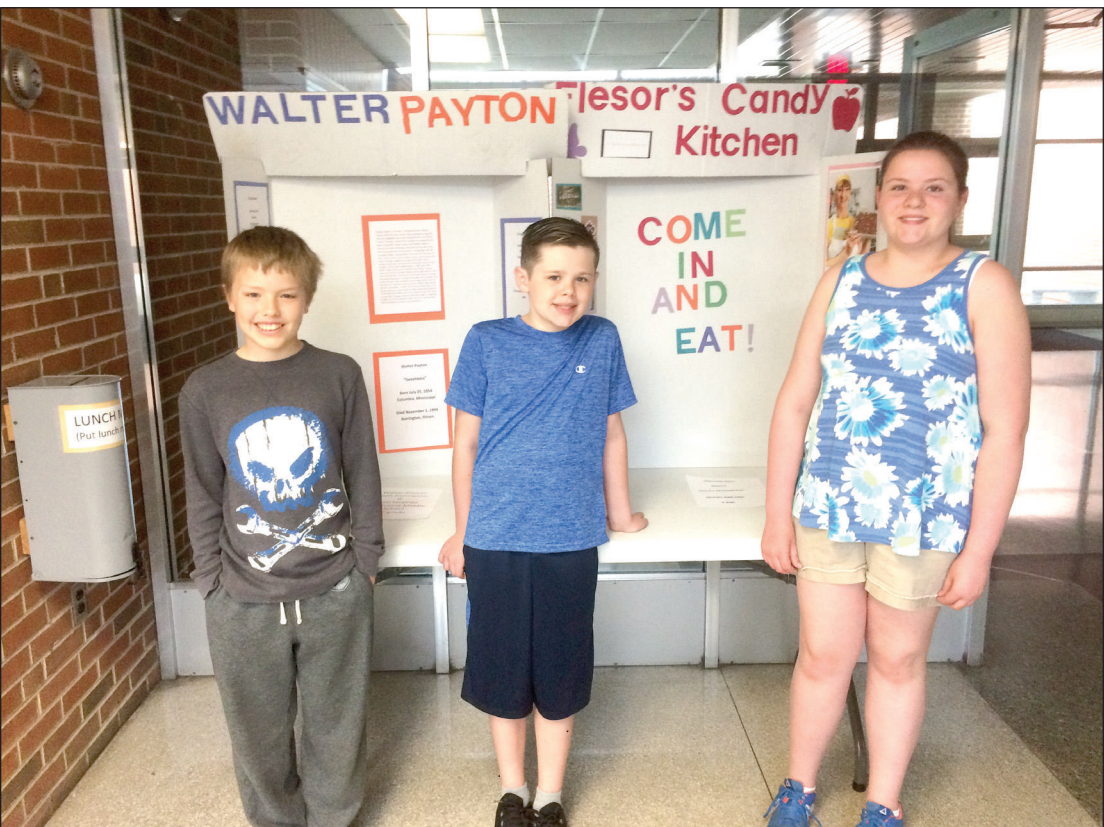
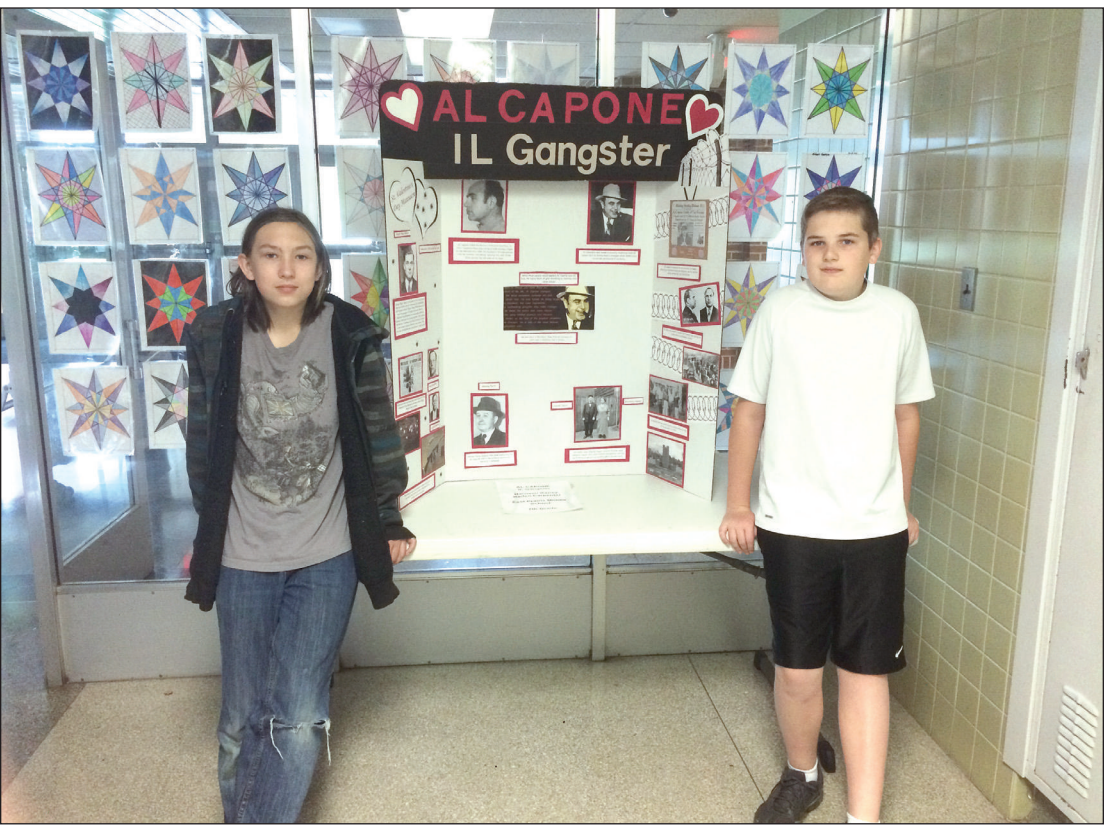

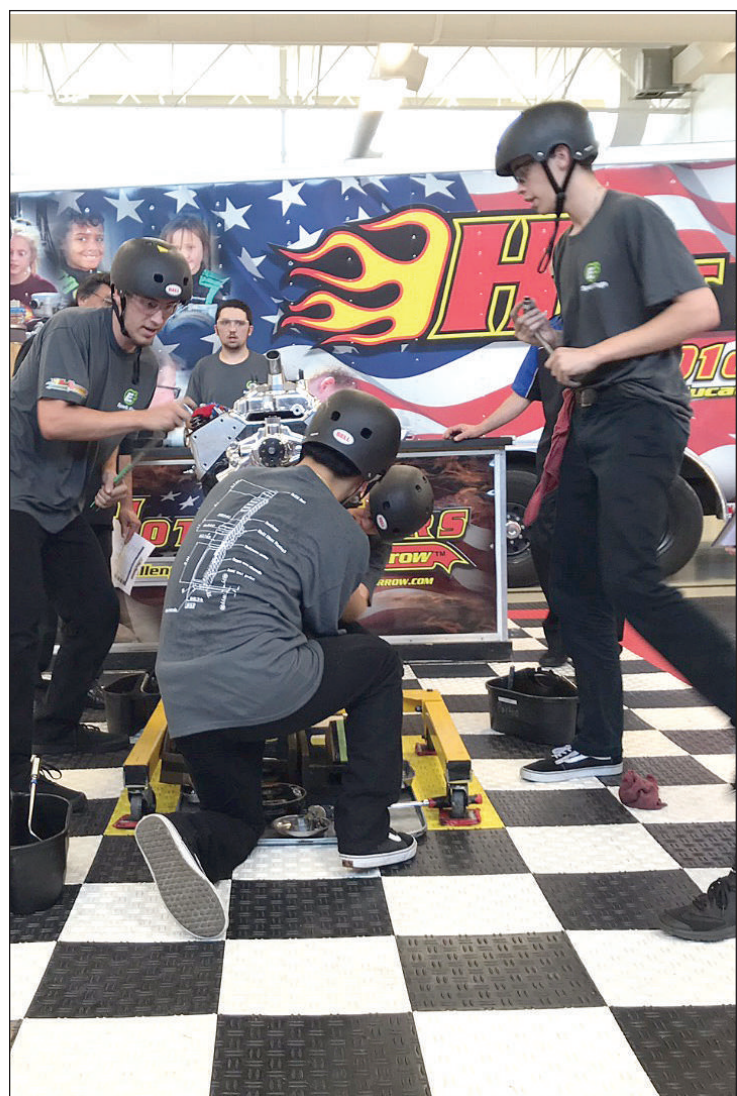
Father Angel Sierra gave the opening prayer and welcomed everyone to the National Day of Prayer at the Forty Martyrs Hall on May 3rd.

The students were required to properly disassemble an engine using hand tools with the proper detorque and disassembly procedure. The students then reassembled the engine using correct assembly procedure and torque specs, all while being viewed by judges. Penalty time was added for dropped components, improper disassembly, assembly, and sportsmanship. The engines, when reassembled, were required to fire and run if gas, water, and oil were added. The qualifying time for the next level of competition in Las Vegas was 33 minutes. The Parkland time finished in 24:10. They will travel to Las Vegas in November to compete in the Dual National Championship.
