Illinois Master Naturalist Program Launched Locally

September 11, 2018 will be the first day of class for a new group of University of Illinois Extension volunteers in Coles, Cumberland, Douglas, Moultrie and Shelby counties. While the Illinois Master Naturalist program is not new for the University of Illinois Extension, it is new for U of I Extension Unit 19.

In Coles County and the others in our Extension Unit, the Illinois Master Gardener program has trained volunteers to disseminate research based horticultural information to residents in the area for many years. The Illinois Master Naturalist program is very similar, but the focus of outreach by volunteers is environmental stewardship. The program is designed to educate and train a corps of volunteers to provide support in the conservation, management, and interpretation of the area's natural resources in collaboration with local partners.

The training provides science-based educational opportunities that connect people with nature and help them become engaged environmental stewards. The initial 40 hours of training will be presented at Douglas-Hart Nature Center through sessions that include lecture, discussion, and hands-on

activities. Training will be every Tuesday, from 9:00 am until 4:00 pm, beginning September 11, 2018 through October 23, 2018. An additional orientation and introductory meeting is scheduled on August 28, 2018 at 6:00 pm.

With the help of local experts, University of Illinois Extension provides the educational support for the program, while volunteering is typically coordinated through local partners. In our Extension Unit, program partners currently include Douglas-Hart Nature Center, Grand Prairie Friends, and the Coles County Soil and Water Conservation District. Volunteer Master Naturalist service projects may include wetland, forest, and prairie restoration; fish, wildlife, and plant inventories; environmental education programs for youth and adults; and interpretive tours at the visitor center. The list of volunteer activities is endless.

So, you might be asking, who can become a Master Naturalist volunteer? Any adult over 18 years of age, who loves the outdoors, has a concern for the local environment, and wants to provide education and service to help their local community. You do not need to have a college degree or years of experience. You do need to have a sincere desire to learn and share information about nature and

be willing to devote time to volunteering and on-going training.

If you are interested in becoming an Illinois Master Naturalist volunteer, you will need to complete an application as a first step. Next, you will participate in an informal interview and orientation. The program participation fee, which covers the cost of classroom and field training, handouts, and the Master Naturalist curriculum manual, is \$150.00. The application deadline for the fall 2018 training is August 3, 2018.
