I plan to work in bees with Mike Hendrix. - Gunner Steedley

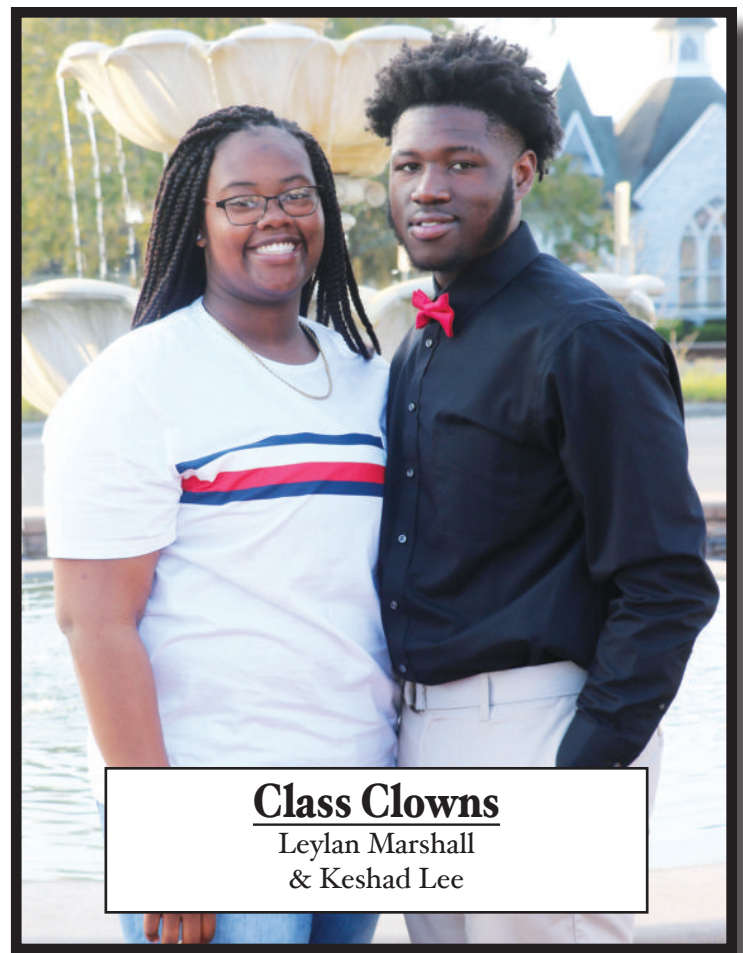

I plan to attend Georgia College and State University in Milledgeville with a computer science degree in mind, but not with 100 percent certainty. - Mitchell Prescott

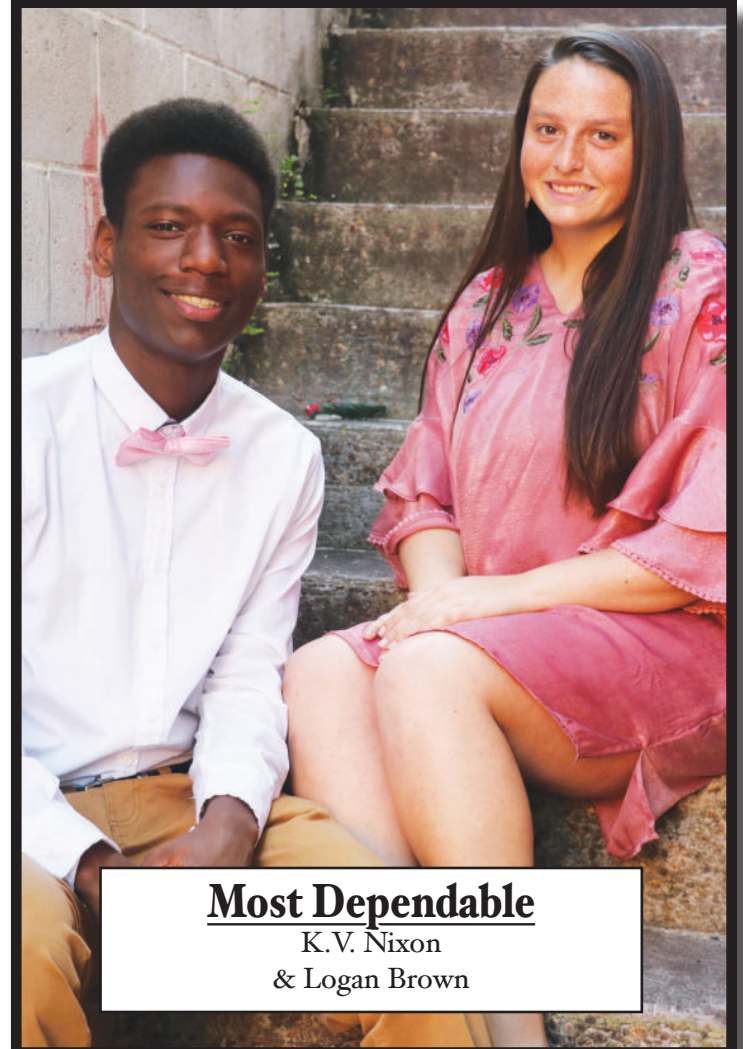
After high school, I plan to attend Valdosta State University to pursue a degree in history education. Afterwards, I plan to teach at a high school level. - Caleb Register
