**Don't forget your Voter I.D.**

State and local election officials are reminding all voters that identification will be required for residents to cast a ballot during the Tuesday, Aug. 6 primary elections.

The following forms of identification are acceptable:

- A driver's license, even an expired one as long as it includes the voter's address and date of birth.
- A photo ID card issued by a branch, department or entity of the State of Mississippi.
- A U.S. passport.
- A government employee identification card.
- A firearms license.
- A student photo ID issued by an accredited



- Mississippi university, college or community/junior college.
- A U.S. Military ID.
- A tribal photo ID.
- Any other photo ID issued by any branch, department, agency or entity of the U.S. or any state government.
- A Mississippi Voter ID Card is available free of charge and the state and

county will assist residents in obtaining necessary documents free of charge in order to apply for a card.

To obtain a free Voter ID, residents must do the following:

- Be a registered Mississippi voter.
- Go to any circuit clerk's office during regular hours.
- Present one form of acceptable documentation, to include:
  - Any expired, but valid, document having the voter's name and photograph issued by the U.S. government or any state
  - A birth certificate or any other document with the voter's full legal name, date and place of birth
  - A Social Security card
  - A Medicare / Medicaid Card
  - A Mississippi Voter Registration Card
  - Any of the following, as long as it includes the voter's name and current address: utility bill, bank statement, paycheck of government check issued within the past six months or an IRS Form W-2, Wages and Tax Statement issued within the current calendar year.

If you do not have any of these documents, call the Greene County Circuit Clerk's office for information on getting a state-issued ID card.

"Mississippi is the only state where if you know your date of birth, state of birth and mother's maiden name, county officials can look up your birth certificate for free," Secretary of State Delbert Hosemann said. "That will give you the information needed to obtain a Voter ID."

Hosemann went on to say that Voter IDs will be issued on election day and even for seven days after that, allowing people to vote by affidavit ballot and then use the Voter ID to verify the ballot cast.

Women who have much of their documents in their husband's name (i.e., Mrs. John Doe) can use their current ID, as the date of birth, address and other information provided from those IDs will be sufficient to allow a person to vote.
