Aug. 3 **IN-PERSON ABSENTEE VOTING DEADLINE**, 12 p.m. Circuit Clerk's Offices open from 8 a.m. until 12 p.m.

Aug. 4 **CAMPAIGN FINANCE 48-HOUR REPORTING DEADLINE** 48-Hour Reports due for candidates and committees supporting or opposing candidates for contributions received on or after Sunday, July 28 at 12:01 a.m. through Sunday, Aug. 4 at 12:01 a.m.

Aug. 5 **ABSENTEE BALLOT BY MAIL DEADLINE**, 5 p.m. Circuit Clerk's must be in receipt of absentee ballots returned by mail for ballots to be timely. *This is not a postmark deadline but an actual receipt deadline.*

Aug. 6 **PRIMARY ELECTION DAY ELECTION** for Statewide, State District, Legislative, County and County District Offices. Polling places open from 7 a.m. until 7 p.m.

Aug. 17 **CIRCUIT CLERK'S OFFICES OPEN FOR RUNOFF ELECTION ABSENTEE VOTING** Voting from 8 a.m. until 12 p.m.

Aug. 20 **CAMPAIGN FINANCE PRE-ELECTION REPORTING DEADLINE**, 5 p.m. Pre-Election Reports are due from only Primary Runoff Election candidates and political committees supporting or opposing those candidates in the appropriate office.

Aug. 23 **IN-PERSON ABSENTEE VOTING DEADLINE**, 12 p.m., for Primary Runoff Election Circuit Clerk's Offices open from 8 a.m. until 12 p.m.
