LCSO makes shooting arrest

The Laurens County Sheriff's Office was dispatched at 9:30 p.m. Tuesday, April 9, to a Laurens residence on South Harper Street in response to a call about a person who had been shot. When deputies arrived, they located the victim, Tommy Williams, with an apparent gunshot wound to his lower extremities.

Investigators were quickly able to identify the alleged shooter as Laurens resident Travis Omandell Miller and located him at a residence on Copeland Street in Laurens.

Miller was taken into custody and placed under arrest just before 1 a.m. Wednesday without further incident and later transported to the Johnson Detention Center, where he was charged with attempted murder, possession of a weapon during a violent crime and possession of a weapon by a person convicted of a violent felony.

The victim was transported to the hospital to be treated for his injuries.

Bond denied in student death

A Pelzer man facing felony DUI charges in connection with the traffic death of a Ware Shoals High School student this past weekend has been denied bond.

According to the South Carolina Highway Patrol, a Volkswagen Cabrio driven by Owen crossed the center line on Highway 25 and struck a Dodge Avenger carrying Ware Shoals students who had left their high school prom Saturday night. Owen is charged with felony DUI resulting in death.

Carter Owen, 27, was released from the hospital and booked into the Greenville County Detention Center on

Ware Shoals High senior Trinity Harrison died at the hospital following the accident. The driver of the Dodge and Owen were also injured in the crash and hospitalized.
