Midwest City will host the eighth annual Made in Oklahoma Festival May 10-11 at the Sheraton Midwest City at the Reed Conference Center, 5750 Will Rogers Rd. The festival highlights Oklahoma's own with more than 80 local vendors including wine, beer, food, art and vendors. There are plenty of indoor and outdoor activities for all ages with live entertainment, home brewing demonstrations, Bloody Mary competition, wine and painting class, car show and more. "We are excited to announce our official partnership with MIO Coalition," said Sara Williams, Midwest City's Special Events and Marketing Manager. "We encourage visitors to stop by their booth to support familiar household brands as well as to discover some new favorites."
