The City of Choctaw has organized a new event for Choctaw Creek Park, located at 2001 N. Harper Road. Rock the Park will be 5 to 11 p.m. May 18.

Jason Young leads the group on vocals, Steven Adams plays lead guitar, Chandler Austin is the drummer, and Ryan Gleason is on bass.

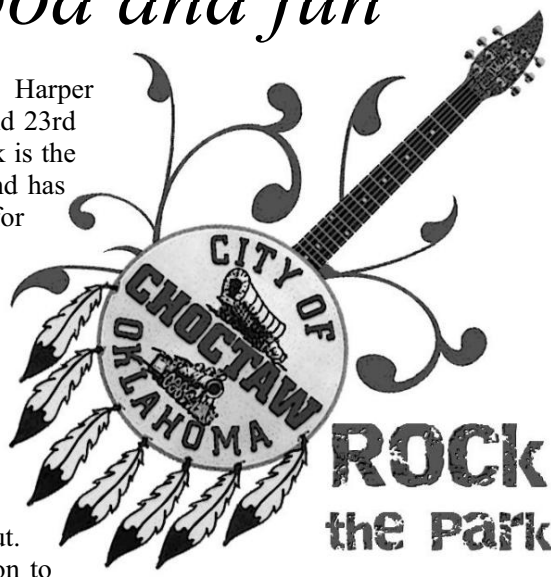

Located at 2001 N Harper Rd, between 10th street and 23rd street, Choctaw Creek Park is the largest park in Choctaw and has many recreational areas for residents to enjoy. Walking trails lead through the park passing a pond with fishing access. Horse trails are accessible from Henney Road and wind through the heavily wooded areas of the park. Picnic tables and benches are available throughout. Recently installed, and soon to be expanded, playground equipment can be found near the entry off of Harper.
