All Air Force Tech Schools are college accredited through the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools and their credits will be transferable to many universities around the U.S. All tech schools specialize in hands on learning in a small class environment.

The Air Force offers 30 days of paid vacation per year, free healthcare, and private living accommodations for all new Airmen after completion of technical training.

# Clay Feland


